Museum Annex Renovation Update

The work to patch, texture and paint the large room and two restrooms will be starting on Tuesday, November 19th. The contractor we hired did a great job on the second large area that is completed and partially set up. *Unfortunately, we still have a leak in the front wall, thought we repaired when scuppers were patched. This* will delay the finishing of the room until the leak is found and patched. The water leak test by the roofing contractor points to leaks around the windows and cracks/holes in the stucco leaking. Jon is sealing the window cracks with foam and caulking to see if this solves the issue. If not, we will the cracks/holes in the stucco repaired and paint the front of building to seal it up.

We are also updating the bathroom fixtures after the texturing and painting is completed. We have received the new ADA toilets to be installed in the Annex.

Then the big task of arranging the displays and setting up the areas for our open house begins.

A little silver-haired lady calls her neighbor and says, "Please come over here and help me. I have a killer jigsaw puzzle, and I can't figure out how to get started."






