
Museum Annex Renovation Progress

We are making slow, steady progress towards the completion of the Museum Annex addition to add new Museum display areas. The left photo below shows the completion of area one with new LED lights and painting and the right photo shows area two after the new LED lights were installed and we have a quote and estimated date for the completion of the area in about two weeks.. We are working on updating the bathrooms with new fixtures and paint. There will also be a new ADA bathroom installed. The work area/lab and two large storage areas are already completed. The rooms have or will have carpet squares installed. There has been additional work in area one with class room area for presentations.

After the building has been completed, next comes the task of arranging the areas and cleaning up to make the space into the useable areas for tours/guests. The plan is to make available hands-on displays and materials to have school visits again as long ago.

MRC has given us several displays to mount in the new area, one being the employee collage that was displayed in the office building several years ago as well as several items from the 100 year celebration that will be put on display.

The Alumni are very appreciative of MRC's support in helping with issues we found in the Annex (lack of power in area one, solving the lack of plant air to power displays, and verifying the water is safe to drink.
